This total represents the number of students who completed the assignment. This class, being a one credit, late start, 7 1/2 week course has a high drop and dropout rate. One section of the class was held each semester. The number assessed represents all who completed the assignment.

This is a face-to-face day course held on campus. All student, in all sections, who completed the assignment were included in the assessment.

The tool proposed in the Master Syllabus was departmental exam. That tool was not used to collect data. Instead, I used the Career Exploration assignment. This assignment required students to either 1) interview a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant, 2) go to a physical therapy clinic and job shadow a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant or 3) review and select job postings for Physical Therapists or physical therapist assistants including roles and responsibilities. All three assignments required students to identify the role and responsibilities of the physical therapist or physical therapist assistant.

6. Briefly describe assessment results based on data collected for this outcome and tool during the course assessment. Discuss the extent to which students achieved this learning outcome and indicate whether the standard of success was met for this outcome and tool.

For this outcome, the standard of success was that 80% of students will correctly answer all test questions related to this outcome. Since an assignment was used instead of test questions, the above results are the percentage of students that received full credit for the assignment. Although in Winter 2016 and Winter 2017 the standard of success was not met, when the semesters are averaged, 80% of the students over the 6 semesters met the standard of success. Looking at the totals for those semesters, 88 of 109 students received full credit for the assignment. This was 80.7% Two of the students who completed the course did not complete this assignment.

At least 80% of students were able to receive full credit for identifying the duties and responsibilities of a physical therapist assistant and physical therapist. The course effectively introduces students to those fields.

In order to improve achievement of this outcome, making the assignment specific to this outcome or adding exam questions that asked students to identify responsibilities of a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant could be added.

While the Career Exploration Project was completed every semester, students were allowed to select one of three options. Only one of the options, collect 4 job postings, 2 for a physical therapist and two for a physical therapist assistant addressed the career opportunities. That assignment did not require students to describe career opportunities, only to identify them. 6. The lack of available data, related to the original outcomes, clearly indicated the need to update the outcomes and perform better assessment. While the content had been updated to provide meaningful learning experiences, the Master Syllabus did not reflect the evolution of the course.

This course is no longer active. HSC 103, which provides information on all WCC health programs and health careers now includes the program information previously covered in PTA 102. If PTA 102 were to be offered again, the master syllabus needs to be updated.
